Who Can Attend ::::

The Winter Retreat is designed for people who are serious about knowing or serving God and seeking to deepen their fellowship with Him. We ask that only mature young people, age 18 or older, join us for the week.

Due to child protection policies, school-age children (under the age of 18) may not attend the Winter Retreat. If you have a question about age requirements or room arrangements, please ring before you book.

What to Bring

Bed linens will be provided, as well as one towel. A shop on site is also provided. Be sure to bring your Bible and pen, an extra blanket, flannels, any required toiletries, recreational money, several changes of clothes (as this is a Christian retreat, please make sure your clothing is appropriate and modest), and an extra pair of hiking boots/wellies for activities. Please be sure to bring WARM CLOTHING! Bear in mind, it will be cold this time of the year. Hats, gloves, scarves, warm socks and anything else to help you keep warm are not an option but a necessity!



Upon Arrival

Upon your arrival at Cefn Lea, there will be a check-in desk where you will be able to finalise any payment details (if needed), be given schedules or arrangements for the week, as well as receive your lodging assignment.

The Cost

The cost for each person for the week is £165.00 (concessions £150.00) if completed online for the week. There will be an additional £10.00 cost for bookings received after Monday, 7 February. The £165.00 (£175.00 for late bookings) includes the cost of food and lodging for the week, as well as a Winter Retreat t-shirt and journal.


